



Southwest Welding and Manufacturing Company was awarded the main contract for the construction of the WAC Corporal Propellent Tanks. Because of material specified (4-6 chrome), approximately twenty different welding techniques were tested in order to select the one most successful in forming an airtight vessel capable of withstanding pressure as high as 3,000 pounds per square inch.

The maintenance of roundness and straightness during heat treatment at 1.725 degrees F. required a continuous support cradle and a pressure of at least ten pounds in each compartment during heating, to prevent collapse.
