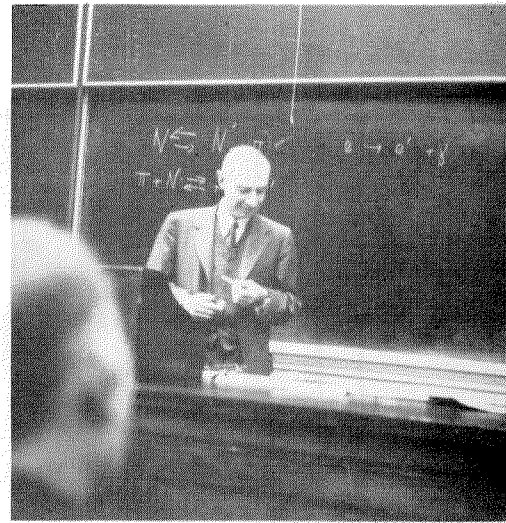




VISITING LECTURER
