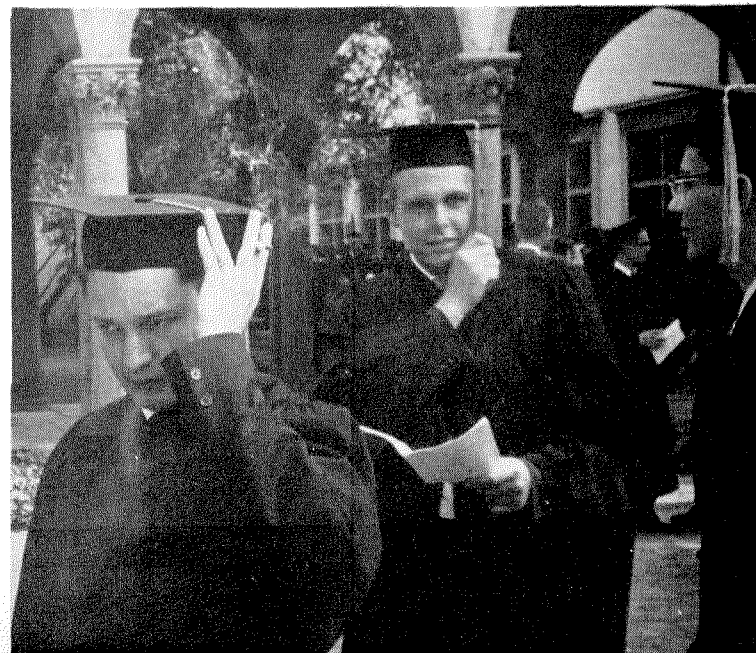
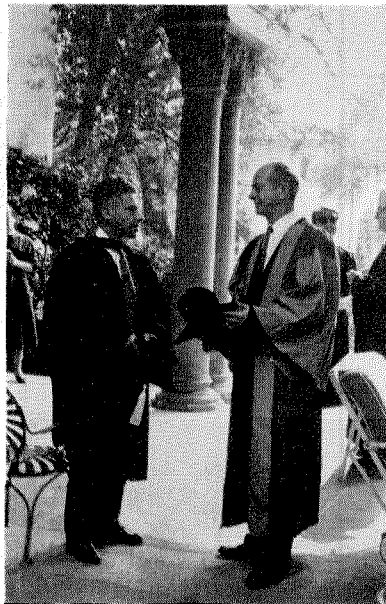
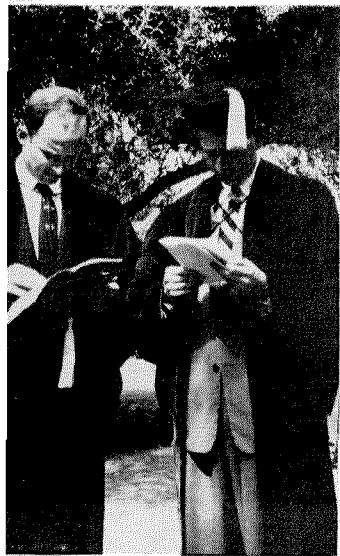




# COMMENCEMENT 1955
