




Helicopter view of the campus, October 9, 1961.

THE CHANGING CAMPUS

Caltech's graduate houses opened for business at the start of the 1961-62 academic year. The dedication of the four new houses (Keck, Braun, Mosher-Jorgenson, and Marks) on October 2 marked the completion of the 13th new structure in the Institute's 18-building development program. Still to come: the Karman Laboratory of Fluid Mechanics and Jet Propulsion which will be dedicated in January; the Firestone Aeronautics Research Laboratory and the Winnett Student Center, now under construction; and the Arnold O.
